Agenda Item #1, 750 Dunham Street Property: Facilities Director Joe Viola received bids for demolition of the Dunham Street property totaling approximately \$16,700, plus costs for permits and utilities. The County had discussed allowing the fire department to use the home as a training site before demolition of the home occurred, however, this would be an extra cost to the County and decrease the value of the property due to the trees having to be removed. This matter will be bought back at the October 5th meeting.

Agenda Item #2, Review and Consider Approval of Brasada Ranch Phase 15
Infrastructure Improvement Agreement and Overnight Lodging Unit Completion
Agreement: At the September 7th County Court meeting the County Court discussed signing the infrastructure improvement agreement and overnight lodging unit completion agreement upon the approval of the Planning Commission. The Planning Commission was to meet on September 14th however, they did not have a quorum and were unable to hold their meeting. The time frame for objections has passed and Brasada would like to proceed. The County Court signed both agreements.
