**Record Number 217-24-000293-PLNG:** Continuation for Deliberations only of Conditional use application for a photovoltaic (pv) solar power generation facility located on property zoned Exclusive Farm Use zone, EFU-3. The proposal includes a ground mounted solar array, gen tie transmission lines, a substation, an energy storage system, and an operation and maintenance facility. The project is proposed to be a 320-acre site, on a portion of property identified as map tax lot: 1615000000300. It is north of an existing solar facility.

The hearing is being held pursuant to Crook County Code (CCC) 18.172 Administration Provisions

The application is subject to review under CCC, Title 18, Chapter 16, Chapter 160, Chapter 161, Chapter 180, the Crook County Comprehensive Plan, Oregon Administrative Rules, and Oregon Revised Statutes.

The hearings will be conducted pursuant to CCC 18.172.081. The evidentiary record was closed at the conclusion of the June 25, 2025 hearing.

**Record Number 217-25-000289-PLNG:** Public Hearing. Legislative amendment to the County's Comprehensive Plan to update the Transportation Systems Plan pursuant to OAR 660-012 and statewide planning goal 12. The TSP is one of the planning requirements for Counties, to plan a safe, convenient, and economical transportation system. This TSP will replace the County's existing TSP. This TSP will plan for the next twenty years of county growth and transportation needs including multimodal travel, necessary connections, and preferred capital improvements.

The hearings will be conducted pursuant to CCC 18.168 Legislative Amendments.

Failure to raise an issue in the hearing, in person or by letter, or failure to provide sufficient specificity to



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afford the decision maker an opportunity to respond to the issue precludes an appeal to the Land Use Board of Appeals based on that issue.
